
CREATE A MEDIA SUBURBAN SCENE WITH CRAYONS



- Divide the paper in half horizontally.
- Divide the bottom half of the paper in half horizontally.
 - the space closest to the bottom of the paper is the foreground
 - the space in the middle of the paper is the middle ground
 - the space closest to the top of the paper is the background



- Draw a horizontal line for the foreground.
- Draw a horizontal line for the background.
- Draw a row of houses along the background line.
- Let the bottom of 1 house be just below this line.



ORGANIC SHAPES - TREES, PLANTS AND BUSHES

• Combine organic shapes to create trees, bushes, rocks and gardens.



GEOMETRIC SHAPES - HOUSES, WINDOWS, STEPS, DOORS

• Combine geometric shapes to create buildings, steps, windows and other details.

SIMPLE SUBURBAN SCENE

- Combine shapes to add details to the houses.
- Draw trees and bushes in front of the houses.
- Make things closest to the viewer bigger and more detailed.



DETAILED SUBURBAN SCENE

- Draw lots of organic shapes for trees, bushes and plants.
- Overlap shapes to show depth.
- Place them so they move your eye in and around the space.
- Add lots of textures and details to the scene.

SIMPLE SUBURBAN SCENE

- Use crayons to colour the picture.
- Colour the foreground with the brightest colours.
- Use 1 or 2 colours in each section.
- Gradually change your drawing pressure to make the colour go from dark to light to give the illusion of depth.



SIMPLE SUBURBAN SCENE

- Use crayons to colour the picture.

- Layer several colours in each section.
- Gradually change your drawing pressure to make the colour go from dark to light to give the illusion of depth.
